

First Impression: Event Policies

Thank you for participating in **First Impression**, City Ballet San Francisco's mock-competition experience. Our goal is to provide a supportive, educational environment where dancers can refine their work and gain insight from industry professionals.

Please review the following policies carefully. By registering, participants and/or their parent/guardian acknowledge and agree to all terms.

1. Registration, Refunds & Cancellations

- All registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable, regardless of circumstance.
- CBSF reserves the right to adjust the event schedule, panelists, or format as needed. Scheduling changes do not qualify for refunds.
- Missed rehearsal or performance times cannot be rescheduled.

2. Photo & Video Policy

- CBSF may take photographs and/or video recordings throughout the event for internal use, documentation, or promotional materials.
- By participating, dancers and their guardians consent to the use of such media without compensation.
- Personal photography and videography may be limited or restricted.

3. Liability Waiver

- I acknowledge the physical nature of dance and the inherent risks associated with participation.
- I agree to assume all risks of injury or accident and release City Ballet San Francisco, its staff, faculty, and representatives from any liability arising from participation in the event.
- I agree to assume all risks of injury or accident and release Chorus Theater, its staff, faculty, and representatives from any liability arising from participation in the event.
- Participants are responsible for managing personal warm-ups, physical readiness, and safe use of the facility.

4. Behavior & Conduct Expectations

- First Impression is a supportive, educational environment. All participants, families, and attendees are expected to uphold respectful and constructive behavior.
- Disruptive, disrespectful, or unsafe behavior may result in removal from the event without refund.
- Participants must follow faculty and staff instructions regarding stage use, spacing, and timing.

5. Facility & Space Use

- Participants agree to respect all CBSF and Chorus Theater property and adhere to rules regarding the use of studios, theater spaces, dressing rooms, and common areas.
- Food and drink (other than water) may be restricted in certain areas.
- Dancers must arrive prepared and on time for their assigned class and performance slots.

6. Feedback Policy

- Feedback is intended for educational purposes only and may not be contested or debated.
- Participants understand that feedback reflects individual professional perspectives and may vary.

7. Parent/Guardian Responsibility (for Minors)

- CBSF does not provide supervision outside of scheduled class or performance times.
- Parents/guardians must remain reachable during the event.
- Dancers should be picked up promptly after their scheduled involvement.

8. Accuracy of Information

- All registration information provided must be accurate and complete.
- CBSF reserves the right to deny participation if false or misleading information is submitted.
